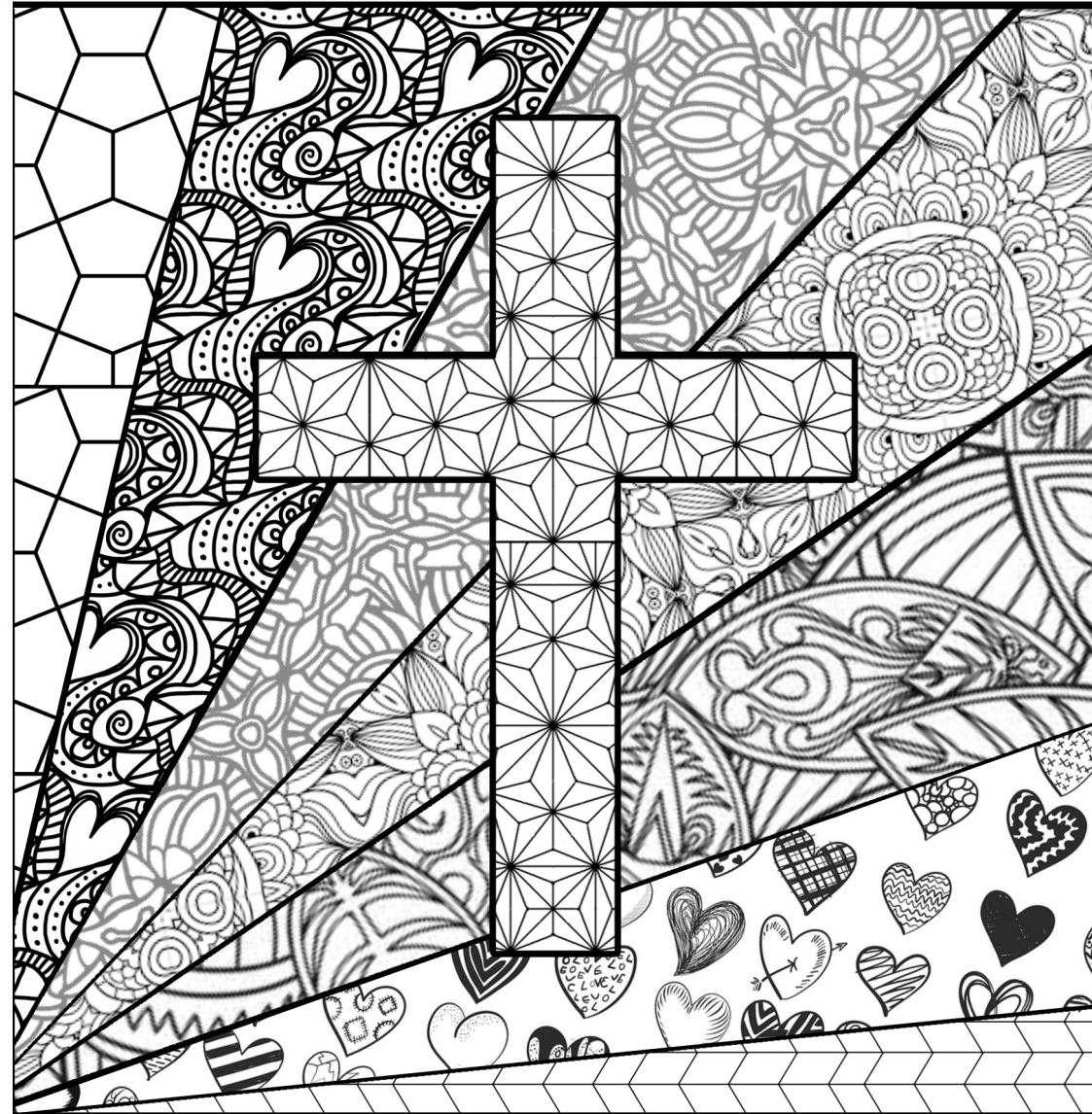

## YOUR FOOD HAMPER

There's a lot of different things here, and sometimes you might find something you've never had before. If there's something you're not going to eat **please pass it on**, don't bin it. You're welcome to ask us what to do with an ingredient

### IMPORTANT

This food box has **not** been packed to meet any specific dietary requirements.

### BEST BEFORE & USE BY

This food has two types of dates, **Best Before** and **Use By**.

**BEST BEFORE** is an indication of quality. Food is still safe to eat after the best before date, but might not be perfect. Some of your food might be past its best before date, but won't do you any harm and is usually still good.

**USE BY** is an indication of safety, food past its use by date may be harmful. Do not consume anything which is past its use by date.

### WHERE THIS FOOD CAME FROM
